

SOS114 ADOPT-A-WEEK VOLUNTEER DESCRIPTIONS

***Kitchen Duty:** 4-5 volunteers from 5:45-7:30pm – Sun.; and 6:00-7:30pm – Mon., Tue. and Thurs.

- **Description:** Before dinner, volunteers will set tables and assist in any last-minute preparations. During dinner, volunteers will supervise the dining area and assist in serving campers. Following dinner, volunteers will wash dishes, sweep the dining area, and clean the kitchen, along with other clean-up jobs. Volunteers are welcome to stay for evening chapel.
- **IMPORTANCE:** This allows the SOS114 staff to spend more time with campers before, during, and after dinner. This is also part of our encouragement ministry – the staff serves all day and this is one opportunity for others to serve them!

** This is one of our most popular volunteer activities, but please do not send more than 5 people for any given night, otherwise some volunteers won't have anything to do! Also, please do not bring children under the age of 12 years of age for this job.*

Daily Prayer: 2-3 volunteers from 7:45-8:15am – Mon., Tues., Wed., Thurs. and Fri.

- **Description:** Volunteers meet at Mt. Moriah East (1248 Haynes Street, 38114) in the morning to pray with staff for campers, homeowners, SOS114 staff and the Orange Mound community.
- **IMPORTANCE:** Prayer is powerful; prayer is Biblical; prayer is one way that God has chosen to communicate with us. Praying at the building sets an example to our staff and campers for committed prayer and submission to God. This also allows the volunteers to actively participate in SOS114 and witness firsthand what happens in this ministry.

***Popsicles:** 1 vehicle of volunteers/day from 2-3:30pm – Mon., Tues., Thurs. and Fri.

- **Description:** Each day we need one vehicle of volunteers (families, Sunday school classes, etc.) to deliver popsicles to the teams at our worksites. Volunteers arrive at Mt. Moriah East (1248 Haynes Street) at 2pm to receive a map to the homes. Volunteers are responsible for buying their own popsicles to deliver. The SOS114 staff will let you know prior to your arrival how many popsicles are needed.
- **IMPORTANCE:** It is hot outside. The popsicle brigade offers a welcomed break to the campers, staff and neighbors. It is an integral part of our encouragement ministry.

Friday Night Dinner: 5-10 volunteers from 5:15-7:30pm – *Fri. only*

- **Description:** Volunteers will prepare and cook a meal for campers, staff and homeowners as a conclusion to the week. However, this is SOS114's turn to serve our volunteers! Volunteers will sit down to enjoy a meal while the SOS114 staff act as servers for the evening. After dinner is served, volunteers will assist SOS114 staff in washing dishes, sweeping the dining area, cleaning the kitchen, along with other clean-up jobs. Volunteers are welcome to stay for evening chapel.
- **IMPORTANCE:** This event is an opportunity for all our teams, homeowners, *and volunteers* to spend time together over a meal. Volunteers help to provide a home-cooked meal and are given the opportunity to hear stories of the week from campers and homeowners.
